

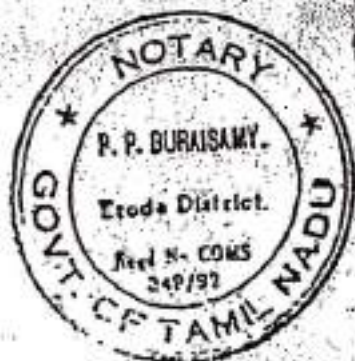

OBJECTIVES OF THE SOCIETY:

  - d. To promote Unity and Friendly Nature and to organise and conduct above caste, creed, language and party by this Trust besides improving and encouraging Arts & Technology and Literature.
  - e. To arrange and help poor students for Educational Scholarships, education for uneducated old people besides helping various social benefits for the poor students.
  - f. To arrange transport facilities for the Students and the general public.
07. Any person of same mind in Erode who is more than 18 years old and who donate either by himself or through his friends more than Rs.60,000/- shall become the member of this Trust. Donor Members who donated a part of the amount on or before 06.03.1993 and fail to pay the balance subsequently shall also lose their right to become a member. Only those who contribute more than Rs.1,00,000 shall only have the right to become members. Further, they also will have the right to become a member of the Governing body.
08. The Secretary shall mainly attend the proceedings of any in the courts or other tribunals in connection with the Trust. He is the person to sue or to be sued on behalf of the Trust.

09. RIGHTS, OBLIGATIONS AND PRIVILEGES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE TRUST:

01. The Members of the Trust shall have the right to participation in General Body Meetings and also to call for such meetings.
02. Every member shall whole heartedly work for the improvement and welfare of the Trust.
03. The Members shall pay an entrance fee of Rs.100/- to the trust.
04. The Members shall pay Rs.120/- as the Annual Subscription every year and the last day for payment is 31st January every year.

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01. Every year member of the Trust shall have the privilege to receive a notice in writing calling for a General Meeting with the Agenda not less than 20 days before the date of such meeting. Such notices shall be served in person or through post or through press.
02. The Members of the Executive Committee shall be elected once in three years.
03. If a patron member dies, the eldest son shall become a member even without Donation of Rs.60,000/-
04. In case the deceased patron member has no male issues, then his wife will become a member without Donation, of Rs.60,000/- After her life; her daughter will become a member. In case the deceased patron member has no issues at all, then the nominated person by him will become a member of Trust.
05. Any person of sane mind and above 18 years in Erode who contributes by way of Donation of Rs.5,00,000, he shall be admitted as a member of this Trust.
06. An extra-ordinary General meeting may be convened by the President, Secretary, Treasurer or on a requisition signed by patron members stating the object for which meeting is to be called for within 25 days of the receipt of such requisition, the Secretary shall convene such meeting.
07. The patron members who contribute the majority viz. 2/3rd of the total strength can call for amendment of the by-laws.
08. The members of the Trust in the General Meeting, the majority of them viz. 4th of the strength present, can remove the membership, who works detriment to the interest of the Trust activities by passing a resolution and leaving is to vote on account.

12. The Secretary of the Trust shall prepare such records annual or other statements which are specified in the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975 and the rules made there under and file them before the concerned Register.

13. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

01. PRESIDENT:

The President is the Head of the Trust and shall preside over all meetings. He shall have the power to supervise and control the activities of the officers of the Trust. The documents and other records shall be under the control of the President. In case of equality of votes, the President shall have a casting vote in addition to his vote. The President shall sign the Minutes of each of the Meeting.

02. VICE-PRESIDENT:

In the absence of the President, the Senior among the Vice-President shall preside over such Meetings and shall have such powers in the meeting as the President has.

03. SECRETARY:

The Secretary shall with the approval of the Executive Committee, call for Annual General Body Meeting in the month of May every year.

The Secretary shall carry out the resolutions passed by the Executive Committee and General Body meeting from time to time. The Secretary shall manage the affairs of the Trust under the control of the Executive Committee. The Secretary shall have full control over the establishment of the Trust and to look after the day to day affairs of the Trust. The Secretary shall do all acts which are considered necessary for the betterment of Trust. The Secretary shall maintain minute of all proceedings of every General Body Meeting and Executive Meetings. The Secretary shall carry on the correspondence on behalf of the Trust.

04. JOINT SECRETARY:

In the absence of the Secretary, the joint Secretary shall have the power to attend to the day to day work of the Secretary.

05. CORRESPONDENT:

The Correspondent shall have the power to look after the day to day affairs of the Management of Colleges of this Trust, members of the staff and servants. He shall have powers to take disciplinary action against the members of the staff and servants. In case of removal from service of the staff member and servants, he shall get the approval of the General Body. The documents; Correspondence collected with the College shall be signed by the Secretary and Correspondent. He is empowered to hold Rs.5,000/- cash interest for the purpose of expenses for the College. The Secretary of the Executive Committee of the Trust shall only function as the Correspondent of the College and other Educational Institutions of this Trust.

06. TREASURER:


The Treasurer shall keep proper books of accounts with respect of all sums of money received and expended by the Trust. He is entitled to keep up to Rs.5,000/- in cash on hand and deposit the balance in bank decided upon by the Executive Committee. He shall operate the Bank account jointly with the President, Secretary and Correspondent.

The Treasurer shall have power to borrow and spend the funds to such limit for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, as may be fixed by the Executive Committee and for the purposes of securing loans from Banks and Financial Institutions, is further authorised to create charges over the properties and assets of the Trust wherever it is necessary subject to ratification by the Executive Committee. The Trust is entirely responsible for the Loan Amount.

07. JOINT TREASURERS:

In the absence of Treasurer, the Joint Treasurers will carry out the duties of the Treasurer.

The Executive Committee shall have the power, on the advice of the members of the General Body, to appoint officers; staff members and servants for the colleges functioning under the trust. The Correspondence shall have the power to take disciplinary action and to remove from service the staff members, servants of the Institution on the advice of the members of the General Body.

- (A). The Income and Property of the Trust whenever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the object of the Trust as set forth in the memorandum of Association and no portion shall be paid or transferred to the members of the Trust.
- (B). Any surplus funds of the trust shall be invested in the manner laid down under Section 13(5) of the Income Tax Act 1961.
16. (A). The Trust may carry such activities which may be required in furtherance of its objects. The Trust has got the right to collect Donations and to buy and sell movable and immovable properties.
- (B). The Trust shall transact its business to the objects as envisaged in the memorandum of Association, conforming to the Rules and Regulations of the Trust.
17. This, being a Trust established for the purpose of running Educational Institutions and for various social welfare schemes and shall not remark any of its funds for making provision for a dependent of a leading good member or a disabled member.
18. The General body meeting of the Trust shall be called by the Secretary once in a year in the month of May and the Meeting shall be called Annual General Body Meeting. An extraordinary meeting of the Trust may be convened at any time by the President, Secretary or any members of the Executive Committee and shall be convened by them on receipt of requisition in writing signed by the 1/10 (One tenth) of total members of the General Body of the Trust stating by which the meeting is to be called for within 25 days of the receipt of the said requisition the Secretary shall convene the same and in default, the requisitionists, themselves may convene the meeting. Notice of all General Body Meeting and Agenda shall be given in writing not less than 21 days before the date of the meeting by the Secretary to each member of the Trust. The quorum for the General Body Meeting shall be 1/3 (One third) of its total members.
19. The Secretary is the person empowered to give directions in regard to the business of the Trust.
20. ACCOUNTS:
01. The financial year of the Trust shall be from 1st April to March every year. The accounts of the Trust shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Executive Committee. The Audited accounts and Balance Sheet shall be placed before the Annual General Meeting for approval. The following documents shall be filed with the Registrar of Societies within one month from the date of the holding of the Annual General Meeting.
- a. An authorised copy of such receipts and expenditure account Balance sheet and report.

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- b. A Statement of the Names, Address and Occupations of the persons who at the expiry of the Financial year were members of the Registered Trust.
- c. A Declaration to the effect that the Trust has been carrying on its operation during the financial year ended.
- d. A Statement as to the change if any, of the Registered office on the Trust, a statement on the change among the members and office bearers of the Executive Committee of the Trust and that of members of the Trust and a statement of mortgage or charge created by the Trust over the assets of the trust.
21. If upon dissolution of the Trust there shall remain after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be sold or distributed among the members of the trust but shall be handed over to a society having similar objects to be determined by votes of not less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the members present at the General Meeting called for the dissolution of the Trust.
22. The Trust shall on requisition made in writing by any member of the Trust and on payment of Rs.10/- shall supply copy of the By-Laws. A member shall be served copy of the receipts and payments accounts, income and expenditure a accounts and Balance Sheet along with the notices calling the Annual General Meeting.
23. Every Officer of the Trust shall be indemnified out of the Trust against any liability incurred by him in defending any proceedings, whether civil or criminal in which judgement is given in his favour or in which is acquitted.
24. The Trust shall pass special resolutions wherever it is provided under the Act such as in the case of amalgamation and division of the Trust and winding up of the Trust and for amending the By-Laws of the Trust.
25. The Books of account, the minute book and the register of members shall be kept open for inspection by the members of the Trust, free of charge, during the business of the Trust.
26. The Provisions of the Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act 1975 shall apply in so far as they are not expressly stated in the bye-laws.
27. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE TRUST:

Their tenure of office is for 3 years. Generally these Executive Committee members will be elected to their office during the month of May. The vacancies in the intervene period shall be filled up by convening extraordinary General meeting. In the meantime, the other Executive Committee members will act on his behalf and manage the same.

The Executive Committee members may resign their posts. The resignation letter must be sent one month in advance to the Executive Committee. The member shall be continued in office till his resignation of office was accepted by a resolution approved in the General meeting or in the extraordinary General meeting. The Executive Committee shall meet once in 3 months and pass necessary resolutions with respect to the affairs of the Trust. The accounts of the Trust from the previous meeting till the date of the above meeting shall be scrutinised.
